Eligibility check and application submission -

- The selection process is based on academic merit, and financial need, with preference given to orphans, children of single parents, differently-abled individuals, and children of armed forces personnel.
- Eligible candidates submitted their application form along with the requisite documentation.

Application shortlisting and assessment -

- KCMET Shortlisted the candidates based on the identified parameters of merit and need.
- The assessment process was adapted to online platform specifically during covid-19 and the verification was done based on documents shared online.

Covid-19 Specific Adaptation -

• To adapt to COVID-19 challenges, the application and the selection process, including document verification, was moved online, ensuring the project's continuous support for students during the pandemic.

Ongoing support and Monitoring -

• Implementing team monitors that students are still studying by collecting marksheets every semester.

Disbursement of scholarship instalments -

- First installment: Rs 5000 was transferred to the awardees bank account after their selection.
- The second installment of Rs 5000 was released upon submission of the required documentation, which includes marksheet of the first semester.

Findings and Analysis

The project's effectiveness in reaching diverse groups is evident from the profile of respondents which include 27% belonging to category of **single-parent families, physically disabled**, and **orphan** and wards of **Central Armed Police Forces**.



Addressing Financial constraints for 77%

Scholarships play a crucial role in overcoming student challenges, **addressing financial constraints for 77%** of respondents.

54%

Scholarships **facilitate continued education**, financial planning, and career attainment with 54% of respondents reported **full fee coverage**.

86% of respondents relying on parental assistance, 7% self-financing, and 4% depending on relatives. The scholarship serves as a crucial tool in reducing financial reliance on families or external sources.



The scholarship serves as a **motivator**, **boosting academic performance for 99% of respondents**. With the second installment linked to performance, students are incentivized to maintain good grades, ensuring a positive impact on their educational outcomes

The **scholarship enhances career prospects by boosting confidence** for 44% of respondents, aiding college admissions in higher education for 34%, and improving job prospects for 14%.

The project's effectiveness is notably highlighted by its reach of 1288 beneficiaries across 12 states, with preference given to candidates with single parents, orphans, differently abled children, and children of the armed forces.
